

NON-TEACHER COACHES / SUPERVISORS AND ASSISTANTS

Background

The Division urges all schools to strive to have faculty members as head coaches or supervisors of their interscholastic school teams. However, should the need arise in a particular school, the Director may approve non-teacher coaches/supervisors and assistants.

Procedures

1. Non-Teacher Coaches/Supervisors
 - 1.1 The coach/supervisor must undergo a criminal record check (see Form 400-1).
 - 1.2 The process required for approval is that outlined in the current Saskatchewan High School Athletics Association bylaw regarding non-teacher coaches.
 - 1.3 Each principal shall have in place a method of ensuring that the team's aims and objectives are in accordance with the SHSAA constitution and Board policies and administrative procedures.
 - 1.4 Non-teacher coaches will be expected to operate their program in accordance with the SHSAA constitution and bylaws.
 - 1.5 Non-teacher coaches approved by this procedure have the same duties and responsibilities as teacher coaches.
 - 1.6 If the need arises, the principal has the authority to end the non-teacher's duties, immediately.
 - 1.7 Non-teacher coaches/supervisors/assistants fall under the volunteer provisions in AP 497.
