The Good Spirit School Division (GSSD), along with other provincial school divisions, was informed about a new update regarding the Saskatchewan Teachers' Federation's actions.

We are pleased to announce that effective Friday, April 12 at 11:59 p.m., the Saskatchewan Teachers' Federation has decided to suspend the withdrawal of all voluntary professional responsibilities, including the provincewide withdrawal of noon-hour supervision and extracurricular services. This decision comes in light of the Government-Trustee Bargaining Committee expressing a renewed mandate and extending an invitation to the Teachers' Bargaining Committee to return to the bargaining table.

As a result of this latest development, GSSD will continue to operate under normal conditions beginning April 13, 2024, with staff providing noon hour supervision and extracurricular services as they normally would.


