These projects would not be possible or successful without the collaboration, cooperation, and patience of school staff, administrators, and students.


## **Melville Comprehensive School**



The existing mechanics area grate was removed from the concrete and replaced with a new, improved style of drainage grate.

A standard washroom was transformed into an accessible washroom.





# **Churchbridge Public School**

Phase Two of a multiyear renovation project involved the science lab, gymnasium mezzanine, and a meeting room in the library. To maximize efficiency within the school, a wall was added to the mezzanine to convert the room into a flex space for band and art. The space received fresh paint, new flooring, and a new sink.









The science lab received new cabinetry throughout, flooring, paint and a new acoustic ceiling.



The remainder of the main corridor received paint and new flooring. A room was built within the library to be used for meetings or a break out space.









### **Preeceville School**

The entrance of the school was opened up to create a warm, inviting, and more efficient use of the space. The wall between the adjacent room was removed to create a space for the students to enjoy.







The Kindergarten room was relocated to a fully renovated space, creating an opportunity to transform the original room into a sensory area and a Student Support Teacher space.

# **Miller School**


